Checks will be returned to artists at the end of the event to those who fully participate. Space is limited. All artists, professional and amateur, are encouraged to submit their work. Parking for artists is free in near-by reserved areas.

ELIGIBILITY AND STANDARDS

- All works must be original and created by the artist. Commercially manufactured items or items produced from commercial kits or molds may not be exhibited.
- A committee selects the participating artists and can approve or refuse submitted works.
- This is a family-friendly event. We request no artwork that depicts nudity or violence.
- Artists must be present and show their work throughout the entire event.

HOW TO APPLY

- Complete the application and provide 3 images of your art.
- Send one check for \$40 made out to Netcong Community Partnership which will be returned at the end of the event.
- Include an artist statement/biography of 200 words or less. Describe your technique, materials, and the processes used to create your artwork. This information will be published on the Netcong Community Partnership website (gonetcong.com) and may be edited before publication.

EXHIBIT SPACES

- Time of Event is 10 am – 4 pm. Set up: 9:00 am • Clean up by: 5:00 pm
- Limit one artist per space. For artist collaborations, only one space is provided.
- Spaces are made available by Netcong Community Partnership. All requests for indoor vs. outdoor space will be fulfilled to the best of our ability based on a first come, first served basis. Day of event space changes will not be considered.
- Electrical power is not available.
- Each space must be kept clean and in good shape by the participant.
- Each artist selected for outdoor space must supply his or her own 10'x10' tent. Area can be windy. Plan accordingly.
- Each artist must bring his or her own displays, such as easels, tables, pedestals, payment equipment, etc.
- As required by law, each artist/vendor is responsible for collecting and turning in state taxes.

ACCEPTANCE AND WAIT LIST

- Space is limited. Apply early.
- Artists will be notified of acceptance or wait list status no later than Tuesday May 29, 2018.
